

Hunterdon Center for Surgery requires you to show ***one*** of the following on the day of your procedure:

Option 1: proof that you're fully vaccinated against COVID-19

Option 2: a hard copy of a negative COVID-19 test (within past 6 days)

Option 3: proof of a recent COVID-19 infection (within last 90 days) from which you've recovered

Option 1: How to show you're fully vaccinated

You're considered fully vaccinated if you had your second Pfizer or Moderna dose or your single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine at least two weeks ago.

Here are the options for demonstrating your COVID-19 vaccination status:

- *A physical copy of your vaccine card*
- *Printed documentation from your health care provider*
- *Printed screenshot from Docket app*

Option 2: How to show proof of a negative COVID-19 test

You must bring a **physical copy** of a COVID-19 test taken *within 6 days of your procedure date*.

- *Rapid (antigen) or PCR tests accepted*
- *Home tests NOT ACCEPTED*
- *Saliva tests NOT ACCEPTED*
- *Must quarantine after your test until your procedure*

Option 3: How to show proof of a COVID-19 infection (within 90 days of procedure)

- *Physical copy of your positive lab results*

If you develop symptoms of COVID-19 while awaiting your surgery please contact a nurse to discuss how to proceed. You may need a COVID test or your procedure may need to be delayed, depending on severity of your symptoms and nature of your procedure.
